The TDOT Long Range Planning Division is seeking a qualified professional with a transportation planning background and a strong interest in multimodal freight transportation and planning. The multimodal freight planner serves as a team leader coordinating the development and implementation of elements of the statewide multimodal freight plan and its compliance with federal transportation legislation.

Multimodal Freight Planner duties include:

- Collecting, processing, and analyzing freight-related data, demographic data, and other data as necessary.
- Developing maps, graphics, and illustrations for presentations and reports.
- Preparing written summaries of analysis and research for use at meetings and in reports.
- Facilitating and supporting statewide Freight Advisory Committees and other stakeholder meetings.

This position initiates and participates in regular collaborative freight planning opportunities with the private sector, metropolitan transportation planning organizations, rural transportation consultation organizations, cities, counties, universities and other state agencies.

Qualifications for this position include:

- Strong interest in transportation planning and transportation policies with emphasis on freight planning.
- Ability to work independently and in a team environment.
- Strong computer skills in areas such as ArcGIS software, data analysis, spreadsheet software, and word processing software.
