

TDOT Environmental Studies Specialist - Advanced

Ecology Section – 4 Positions

This is the advanced level of the TDOT Environmental Studies Specialist Series. An employee in this class is a lead worker responsible for identifying and completing environmental studies required for federal and state-funded transportation projects. This position will work with project development and operational staff to coordinate environmental studies with consideration of the overall project schedule. An employee of this class will be responsible for complex projects and studies. The ideal candidate should have experience related to transportation projects including stream identification and wetland delineation, stream and wetland assessment, familiarity with the 401/404 permitting process, and endangered species coordination. Duties include a combination of office work and field work, possibly in adverse conditions with overnight travel occasionally required.
