Highway Beautification Office (1 Position)

The Transportation Program Monitor 1 (TPM1) is the entry level class in the Transportation Program Monitor series. This class flexes to a Transportation Program Monitor 2 (TPM2) after the successful completion of a one year probationary period.

This TPM1 position will report to the Transportation Program Supervisor in the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT), Environmental Division, Beautification Office.

This TPM1 will monitor transportation-related environmental programs, compile and analyze data, develop reports and educational materials, and work with stakeholders to achieve program goals. The TPM1 will be responsible for developing educational and outreach materials. The TPM1 will work with volunteers in a wide range of community programs across the state. The TPM1 will make public presentations and conduct training workshops for groups of 20 or more people. The TPM1 will also be responsible for marketing and promoting environmental outreach programs.

The TPM1 will be expected to engage in strategic thinking to find synergies between environmental programs. The TPM1 position will be responsible for day-to-day monitoring and coordination of several transportation programs, including TDOT's Litter Grant Program, Adopt-A-Highway Program, and Scenic Roadway Program.
