




I-24 Corridor Map








2010 Population by County








2010 Employment by County






2040 Employment by County






Delay in the I-24 Study Area






Average Speed in I-24 Study Area






Truck Trips in I-24 Study Area






Truck Travel in I-24 Study Area






Peak Hour Congestion Along I-24
