FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of TEN DOLLARS AND NO/100 (\$10.00) cash in hand paid, and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt and Sufficiency of all of which is hereby acknowledged, and pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, 25 USC 465, the MISSISSIPPI BAND OF CHOCTAW INDIANS, (Grantor) by and through its duly authorized officer does hereby sell, convey, and warrant unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA in trust for the MISSISSIPPI BAND OF CHOCTAW INDIANS (Grantee), the following described real property lying and being situated in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Civil District of Lauderdale County, Tennessee and more particularly described as follows, to wit:
