Overview

The Headquarters Asset Management Division is responsible for the administration of several statewide programs to ensure the state roadway network and highway assets are maintained at a high-level using cost effective measures. Specific responsibilities include: development of an annual roadway maintenance budget, emergency management planning, pavement management, interagency and city maintenance agreements, and development of roadway maintenance contracts.

Responsibilities

The Asset Management GTA's responsibilities include assisting with the preparation and development of the annual Consistency Determination report for the Transportation Asset Management Plan (TAMP) and any additional needed updates. The GTA will also assist with the coordination of the FHWA Emergency Relief Program to recover federal aid funding for eligible disaster events. Additionally, the GTA will assist with the quality assurance and management of highway asset inventory data collection to develop an Integrated Maintenance Management System.

Qualifications

A Bachelor's or Master's degree in Civil Engineering is required. Additionally, the GTA must pass the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Examination within eleven months of employment.

The ideal GTA candidate has experience in Microsoft office software, the willingness to learn GIS software and LiDAR point clouds, the ability to communicate and negotiate in a fast-paced, productive office environment.
