Overview

The Occupational Health and Safety Division develops and implements policies, specifications, and procedures to ensure the health and safety of people inspecting, maintaining, constructing, and traveling our transportation system. The Division requires individual accountability, expects all employees to adhere to safety standards, and actively participates in and supports the advancement of health and safety practices.

Responsibilities

The Occupational Health and Safety GTA's primary responsibility will be providing assistance and support for the implementation of policies, guidelines and procedures for TDOT's Engineering Field Services office. The GTA will become familiar with work zone traffic control designs, equipment and specifications, and participate in after-incident reviews and investigations. Additionally, the GTA will apply engineering principles to identify work zone preventative measures and assist in the oversight of TDOT's Safety Program and comprehensive safety metrics by which success is measured.

Qualifications

A Bachelor's or Master's degree in Civil Engineering is required. Additionally, the GTA must pass the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Examination within eleven months of employment.

The ideal GTA candidate would have strong communication skills, both written and verbal, is well organized and good with time management, and can work well with others.
