Overview

The Structures Division is responsible for designing and developing plans and specifications relating to all highway structures and for the inspection of all bridges in Tennessee. Key responsibilities include design of foundation conditions, tolerances and complex geometry; the design of major or unusual structures; resolution of hydrology and hydraulic problems; coordination of Geological Survey services; processing of federal disaster assistance, design and development of contract plans specifications; development of automated structural detailing systems; and bridge inspection.

Responsibilities

The Structures GTA will work in the design office and responsibilities include providing grade sketch/clearance calculations, completing bridge preliminaries and completing other design tasks for pre-stressed concrete bridges. Additionally, the GTA will complete retaining wall designs and checks, review shop drawings and attend field reviews.

Qualifications

A Bachelor's or Master's degree in Civil Engineering is required. Additionally, the GTA must pass the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Examination within eleven months of employment.

The ideal GTA candidates will have experience working in technical software such as MicroStation or AutoCad and has a basic understanding of structural principles.
