# Innovative Delivery Hamilton County

The TDOT Innovative Delivery team is seeking a self-driven candidate who has current working knowledge of TDOT policies and procedures and is looking for an experience building opportunity to develop themselves and expand their career opportunities in a fast-paced working environment. This position will be involved in the innovative delivery process, which utilizes Design-Build contracts and the Construction Manager-General Contractor method. These methods allow for partnerships to be developed with the contractor and ultimately seek to decrease project delivery time. As part of the Innovative Delivery team, you will have the opportunity to follow the lifecycle of a roadway project and gain an understanding of the entire PPRM process.

#### **Essential Job Duties:**

- Acts as a project manager over multimillion-dollar, Innovative Delivery roadway projects, and is
  responsible for monitoring contracts, policies, specifications, budgets and schedule
  development throughout the project lifecycle.
- Attends project meetings with contractors to gain information on the progress of the construction project, upcoming events in the schedule, and possible problems associated with the project.
- Assists in the development of the Request for Proposal (RFP) and ensures the contractor adheres to requirements outlined in the contract and analyzes any alternative technical concepts as necessary to ensure modifications are not in violation of the RFP.
- Evaluates design plans and ensures design processes are followed. Evaluates field design changes and records the plan changes in PlanGrid.
- Continuously communicates project information to all internal and external stakeholders involved in the design and construction of a project; and offers guidance in solving technical questions and resolving issues.
- Reviews lane closures and weekly traffic control; and assist in monitory work zones to ensure compliance.
- Evaluates submittals for Consultant Engineering Inspection approvals, and processes change orders while adhering to department policies and procedures.
- Involved in the pre-work for the CM/GC such as design review, material selection, scheduling, risk assessment and methods to mitigate these risks during preconstruction process.
- Conducts daily site visits to monitor progress to ensure operations are running smoothly and projects are delivered in a responsible and timely manner.
- Reviews CPM schedules to determine proper progress is being made on projects and that the
  progress indicated on the contractor's schedule accurately reflects field progress to ensure
  project is delivered on budget and pay estimate requests accurately reflect the work completed
  in the field.
