Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring a full-time Transportation Project Specialist SR professional for our Headquarters location in Davidson County.

The Asset Management Division is responsible for the administration of statewide programs to ensure the state roadway assets are maintained at a high-level using cost effective measures. Specific responsibilities include development of an annual roadway maintenance and resurfacing budget, pavement management, and development of maintenance contracts.

Responsibilities

Assist with selection and development of pavement resurfacing projects to ensure long term performance of the pavement program and review of engineering plans, specifications, and cost estimates (PS&Es).

Manage third-party vendors for collection of pavement, structural, and surface condition data and develop formal pavement condition data reports.

Qualifications

Bachelor's from an accredited college or university with a major in Civil Engineering with experience equivalent to five (5) years of professional civil engineering work

Master's from an accredited college or university in civil engineering with experience equivalent to four (4) years of full-time professional civil engineering work.

Registration as a professional engineer with the State of Tennessee in either the civil engineering or the structural engineering disciplines may substitute for the required bachelor's degree.

Special skills, knowledge or experience required or desired

A background in highway engineering including but not limited to pavement construction, maintenance, design, testing, management and/or evaluation.

Ability to read and review engineering plans.

Have broad knowledge of the State of Tennessee or similar state construction specifications and their application toward pavement construction.
