TDOT Technician – 1 Position

One TDOT Technician position is open in the following office location:

- Chattanooga

This position will require frequent statewide travel.

Traffic Data Collection Responsibilities

Ensure data collection vehicle is supplied properly with traffic counters, road tubes, chains, locks, clamps, nails, etc.

- Travel to the correct location where a traffic counter is to be placed.
- At the location, secure the road tube to the road surface using the clamps and nails. The road tube is plugged on one end and the other end will be connected to the traffic counter.
- Properly enter the correct station identification into the counter. Secure the counter to a sign pole, light pole, or guardrail using a chain and lock.
- Counters are left at each location for 24 hours. When returning to each site, download the traffic count data onto notebook computer using the proper software. Collect all equipment and ensure it is properly stored back in vehicle.
- Repeat this process at each location to be counted.
- Once per week, the downloaded traffic count data is sent in to the office for further processing.
