Overview

The Headquarters Construction Division is responsible for the Operations Contract Administration functions for the Tennessee Department of Transportation. This division manages the specifications, policies, and procedures for the construction field offices across the state. The Construction Division also spearheads innovative initiatives such as new construction methods, e-construction, and alternative contracting.

Responsibilities

The Construction GTA's responsibilities include assisting in the administration of the Consultant Engineering Inspection Program by reviewing invoices, work orders, addenda's, and evaluations. The Construction GTA will also focus on providing guidance to Local Programs projects, reviewing proposals and analyzing bids for concurrence. In addition, this GTA will provide support and collaboration with the Civil Rights Division's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program and other initiatives for construction contracts. Lastly, the Construction GTA will assist in Contract Administration duties by reviewing plans, proposals, and Change Orders.

Qualifications

A Bachelor's or Master's degree in Civil Engineering is required. Additionally, the GTA must pass the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Examination within eleven months of employment.

The ideal GTA candidate has experience in Microsoft office software, the willingness to learn, the ability to communicate and negotiate, and work in a team environment.
