Overview

The Aeronautics Division supports, promotes, and delivers services that encourage and enhance a sustainable, efficient and safe air transportation system in Tennessee. The division provides financial and technical assistance to publicly owned airport operators for the planning, development, promotion, construction and operation of public-use airports throughout the state. Other engineering and planning services include aviation planning studies, environmental planning and compliance assistance, airport geographic information system (AGIS) studies, and project design consultation services to state public-use airports.

Responsibilities

The Aeronautics GTA will work under a senior project manager and will be assigned to approximately 10-15 Tennessee airports. In partnership with the supervisor, the GTA will provide engineering guidance and advice to local officials by reviewing airport project requests, eligibility requirements, and ensuring state and federal requirements are met. The GTA will attend review meetings to collaborate with airport consulting firms on the planning and development of projects. This position will learn how to monitor funding for airports, prepare a funding recommendation prior to contract request, and process airport reimbursements for payment.

Qualifications

A Bachelor's or Master's degree in Civil Engineering is required. Additionally, the GTA must pass the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Examination within eleven months of employment.

The ideal GTA candidate will have strong communication skills and be comfortable presenting technical concepts to groups of professionals. Experience in technical writing, project management and basic civil engineering concepts is preferred.
