Legally authorized to work in the U.S.




Must pass the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE)
Examination within 11 months of starting employment with TDOT

CAREER ADVANCEMENT OPPORTUNITY

After a one-year probationary period, those who successfully complete the GTA program will promote into the working level job classification and receive a salary increase.


