Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring full time civil engineers for Region 2 Operations in Construction and Maintenance Units. Positions are available in Bradley, Cumberland, Coffee, Hamilton, Sequatchie and Warren Counties.

Region 2 is responsible for the department operations that cover the lower East Tennessee area of the state, as well as part of Middle Tennessee. Major areas of operational responsibilities are highway maintenance and repair, construction engineering, traffic and highway marking, bridge repair and inspection, state aid program and administration, materials and tests, highway beautification, environmental planning, and office administration.

Responsibilities

Interprets construction plans, standard drawings, and schematics to identify quantities, location, placement, features, and details to guide assigned work.

Explains project specific procedures and regulations to the general public, persons in other departments or divisions, or outside organizations and representatives as required.

Calculates roadway quantities of materials given set parameters to estimate time, materials and other factors for a project.

Ensures pay quantities for monthly progress payments are paid to contractors and accurate.

Evaluates environmental, safety, and other features of structures and roadways visually before, during and after the completion of assigned tasks to ensure compliance with standard drawings, plans, and specifications.

Conducts inspections of sites, roadway features, equipment, and/or materials to determine that the job is being completed as specified according to local, state, and federal guidelines to ensure standards are met.

Qualifications

Bachelor's or Master's degree in Civil Engineering

One (1) year of full-time professional civil engineering work

Must have passed the FE (Fundamentals of Engineering) exam

Possess a valid Driver's License
