

Mobility and Accessible Transportation Supervisor Multimodal Division

The TDOT Multimodal Division is seeking a qualified, motivated professional with experience in transit and mobility to lead staff and develop new program areas. This position works towards TDOT's vision to serve the public by providing the best multimodal transportation system in the nation. This position will work in partnership with state agencies, public and private organizations, and TDOT to expand mobility choices and accessibility. The Mobility and Accessible Transportation Supervisor will oversee one to six program monitor staff working on transit policy and programs; accessible transportation for low-income, rural, senior and disabled populations; first-mile last-mile solutions; and mobility and demand management strategies.

The Mobility and Accessible Transportation Supervisor will use collaborative management and creative problem solving to deliver the following actions:

- Implements policies, projects and new initiatives that support accessible transportation and mobility for all, including rural, low-income, disabled, senior and special needs populations.
- Implements policies, projects and new initiatives that support transit use, low-speed and shared mobility options, and demand management.
- Creates central mobility management function to support transportation needs of specific communities, identify service options, centralize and coordinate providers, and develop transportation and demand management strategies to respond to those needs.
- Collaborates and coordinates with federal, state, regional and local partners to expand and improve mobility and accessible transportation options.
- Oversees implementation of the State employee transit and commute benefits program.
- Assists staff to administer federal and state grants, contracts and compliance activities
- Support transit agencies with relevant state and federal resources.
- Provides stakeholder outreach and education on mobility and accessible transportation needs.
- Works with data partners to identify, prioritize, and plan transportation projects.
- Implements the staffing plan, develops direct reports, and supports productivity of staff.
- Monitors legislative actions at the federal and state level and provides leadership with an assessment of impacts mobility and accessible transportation policies or funding.
