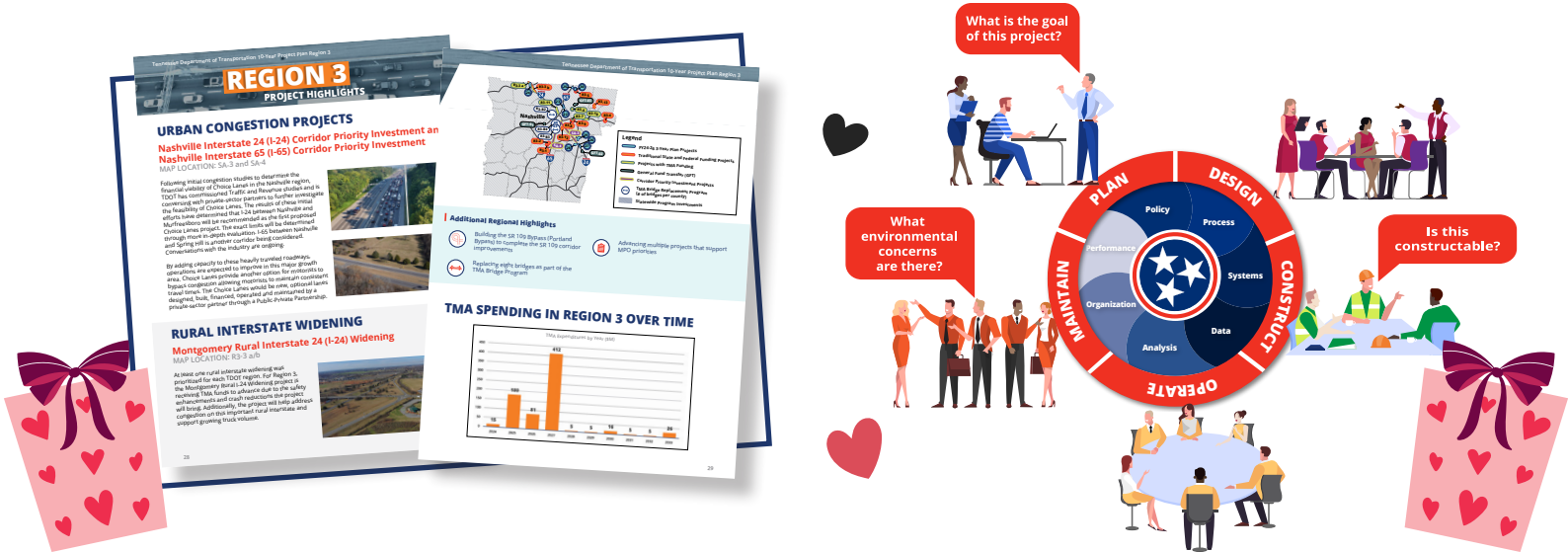


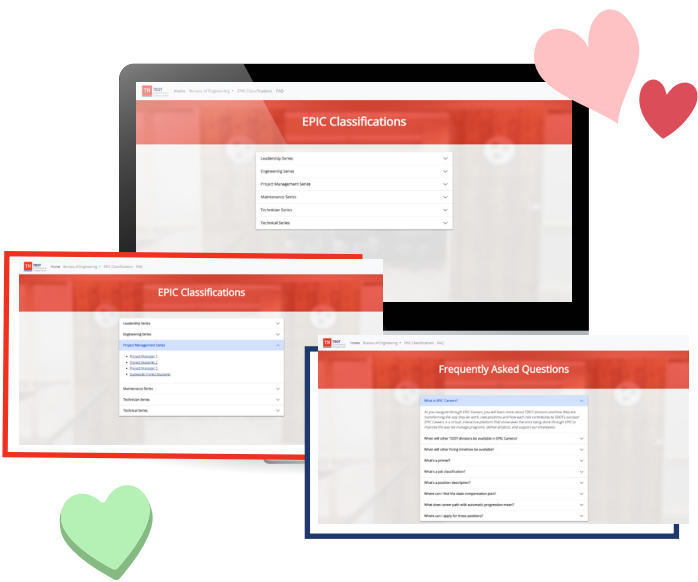
Project Management and the 10-Year Project Plan

TDOT employees play an essential role in the successful delivery of the [10-Year Project Plan](#) and the critical projects funded by the Transportation Modernization Act. The projects listed in the 10-Year Project Plan are everyone’s priority moving forward and there are 93 site-specific capacity-type projects listed in the plan.

The Project Delivery Network (PDN) will be used as a guide in the delivery and management of these projects, with some starting in Phase 1 and others in Phases 2 or 3. Out of the 93 projects, 67 are schedule and funded to be let to construction by the end of Fiscal Year 2028, and 53 already have an internal or external Project Manager (PM) assigned. Region 1 has 19 of those 67 projects, Region 2 has 13, Region 3 has 16, and Region 4 has 19.
