The Budget and Forecasting Team Lead will supervise technical staff and implement performance plans, schedules, and budgets to ensure expected outcomes, performance, and accountability. The Budget and Forecasting Team Lead will research national best practices within the Budget and Forecasting Team and report and recommend ideas to promote innovation and efficiency in statewide budget development and financial planning while ensuring quality assurance to achieve program effectiveness.

Essential Job Responsibilities

Manage resources and staff utilization to allow the Budget and Forecasting Team to perform their roles effectively and efficiently, optimizing the Team's ability to successfully address unanticipated challenges and deliver exceptional financial planning, forecasting, and budget development. Foster a collaborative and high-performing work environment that encourages continuous learning, innovation, and accountability, while ensuring consistent budgetary practices and alignment.

Manage resources and support Department-wide budget development and forecasting functions to coordinate the strategic planning of financial resources and ensure alignment with TDOT's mission and strategic priorities. Manage resources and staff to support the annual budget process, ensuring timely, accurate, and transparent coordination with Finance and Administration, Division Directors, and Regions. Maintain a fully cash-flowed financial plan and ensure project funding stability through alignment with federal allocations and state legislative authority. Serve as a resource for all Division and Region staff, answering budget and forecast-related questions to facilitate informed decision-making.

Integrate quality management standards into all work products, processes, and services in compliance with Quality Assurance guidelines. Identify and take necessary actions to achieve strategic vision and goals, ensuring intended outcomes for scope, schedule, and budget while enhancing quality in coordination with leadership expectations.

Manage change, clarify the vision, take ownership of the change, communicate effectively, remain transparent, and hold yourself and others accountable throughout the process.

Ensure that budgeting processes and financial forecasts adhere to federal and state funding requirements and legislative appropriations.

Guide the development and implementation of technology in partnership with the TDOT Information Technology (IT) Division that ensures program success while adhering to Federal and State finance and budgeting laws, regulations, policies, and standards. Participate in peer exchanges with State and local governments and applicable industry partners for key insights and collaboration.

Assist in and collaborate with the Budget and Forecasting Team to ensure clear communication, financial accountability, and alignment with Department-wide Fiscal strategies. Provide oversight in the development of budget and forecasting work products and services that are consistent, predictable, and repeatable to provide consistently high levels of achievement, mitigation of risk, and an established track record of success.
