### **Overview**

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring a student interns to work in the Construction offices located in Harriman, LaFollette, and Maryville, TN. The Construction will get a chance to work in the field to see the process of milling, paving, striping, and signing the roadway for CNV346, an interstate paving project. These interns will lead two bi-weekly progress meetings which will include TDOT District and contractor personnel. These interns will also develop a presentation to regional leadership demonstrating what you have learned.

### **Responsibilities**

- Assist District Specialists with paperwork, surveying, measuring quantities, etc.
- Report to the office and either ride with TDOT personnel or drive to the project each evening.
- Attend daily meetings at the start of each evening to discuss what work will be completed and the operations the contractor plans to start and finish during the work shift.
- Inspect daily traffic control for safety and MUTCD compliance.
- Communicate with TDOT personnel, and contractor personnel, regarding various aspects of the project.
- Take a turn handling each task that the inspection staff will normally handle. These include taking tickets for asphalt, taking temperatures for asphalt, walking behind the milling machine checking the roadway to see if additional milling is required, following the striping machine, etc.
- Input quantities into SiteManager daily for what work was performed each shift.

### **Minimum Qualifications**

- Civil Engineering, or Construction Management major required.
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2022 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2021.
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
- Technical problem solving and strong communication skills preferred.
- Experience in using MicroStation/Geopak, Primavera P6, and Microsoft Office is preferred.
