Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring a student intern for the Field Services section of the Materials & Tests division, located in Knoxville, TN. The primary focus of this internship is to learn and understand the sampling and testing procedures for roadway construction material both in a lab setting and in the field. The intern will learn the basic sampling and testing methods for aggregate, asphalt, and concrete. They will spend several weeks performing precast and prestress inspections. Also, the intern will assist in performing field testing with the LTL-M Reflectometer for striping and the profiler for road smoothness. If time allows the intern will perform a study on the reflectivity results versus aging on both thermoplastic and paint striping lines.

Responsibilities

- Learn procedures for sampling materials and safety in using lab equipment.
- Download test data and complete the striping reports for each completed route/county.
- Perform concrete testing.
- Perform aggregate gradations on several coarse and fine aggregates and perform a rock/dirt proctor (AASHTO T11, T27, and T99) on material received in the lab.
- Complete reflectometer testing on the Regional Performance Based Striping contracts.
- Work with construction materials, gather field samples, perform tests, and report results.

- Civil Engineering or Engineering major required.
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2025 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2024.

- Interest in construction materials such as aggregate, concrete and asphalt, and desire to learn testing methods in a lab setting and in the field.
