Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring student interns for the Design Office located in Chattanooga, TN. The Roadway Design Office is responsible providing guidance and oversight for TDOT personnel by establishing roadway design criteria, maintaining and developing roadway design standards and training manuals, ensuring roadway plans meet the state and federal policies as well as the targeted quality assurance and compliance standards. These interns will create and understand the development of roadway Right-of-Way and Construction plans for resurfacing, transportation improvement, or maintenance projects. They will also gain knowledge focusing on how the mediation between multiple departments within TDOT is completed through the development of plans.

Responsibilities

- Develop a set of plans for the resurfacing program to include a title sheet, notes section, quantity calculations, and typical sections.
- Attend meetings and site visits for assigned projects.
- Complete and develop resurfacing plans or other projects which is the use of the computer plus possibly meeting for site visits on projects within the Teams.
- Assist assigned Specialist with quantity calculations and roadway design by using Microstation and Geopak software.

Qualifications

- Civil Engineering major required.
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2021 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2020.
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
- Familiarity with foundational transportation engineering concepts, AutoCAD, Microsoft Office, Microstation, and Geopak software preferred.

Selected candidates will be required to provide two letters of reference (professional, or personal).
