Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring student interns for the Survey Office located in Chattanooga, TN. The survey intern will be responsible for learning and performing field and office tasks to complete a TDOT highway survey of easy to moderate difficulty. The intern will also utilize traditional survey methods as well as LiDAR and/or photogrammetry to collect data daily. Last, the intern will perform property, Railroad and Deed Research, and create a deliverable in MicroStation or ORD CADD Platforms daily.

Responsibilities

- Map and capture survey data utilizing CADD and ArcGIS software.
- Conduct field survey, data analysis, and quality control.
- Learn to identify relevant field information needed for Location projects.
- Create survey files as needed.
- Prepare for and hold project survey kick off meeting.
- Extract LiDAR data for CADD Processing

Qualifications

- Civil Engineering, Surveying and Mapping Science, Geomatics, or GIS & Geography, Forestry, or Geology major required.
