- Graduation from a standard high school
- Four (4) years of experience in one of the following roles:
 - Emergency response work
 - Protective services
 - Medical services
 - Customer service
 - Driving motor vehicles for a business and/or government entity
 - Automotive/Diesel maintenance and/or repair
 - Highway maintenance or construction work
- One (1) of the four (4) years must be supervisory experience.
- Supply a fingerprint sample in a manner prescribed by TBI
- Submit to and pass a pre-employment screening test for use of illegal drugs
- Possess and maintain a class D driver's license

Overview of Position

The Department of Transportation is currently hiring a full-time Highway Response Operator Supervisor 1 position for our Region 2 TMC & HELP Trucks unit in Hamilton County. The TMC & HELP Trucks patrol metropolitan roadways to keep traffic congestion and delay time to a minimum.

The Highway Response Operator Supervisor 1 performs highway emergency response work. The position supervises a crew of Highway Response Operators on an assigned shift.
