#### Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring student interns for the Materials & Tests – Geotechnical office, located in Nashville and Chattanooga. The intern will assist Geotechnical Staff with geological identification and field data collection using standard geotechnical resources for select project(s). Historic information and new field data will be used to develop sections of, or a complete, report in accordance with the TDOT Geotechnical Guidelines. Typical deliverables include Soils and Geology Reports, Geohazard Reports (sinkholes, rockfall, landslides, etc.), and Foundation Reports.

#### Responsibilities

- Meet with Geotechnical Staff to become familiar with Soils and Geology Reports, the TDOT Geotechnical Guidelines, and other applicable design guidance manuals.
- Participate in field visits to learn data-collection methods and understand the importance of accurate field documentation.
- Produce a draft Soils and Geology Report or other applicable report based on collected field data.
- Read Design Plans and develop a Geotechnical Work Plan and Drilling Plan.

#### Minimum Qualifications

- Engineering, Geology, Earth Sciences, or Construction Management major required
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2026 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2025.
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
- Interest in geotechnical work preferred.
