Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring a student intern for the Region 2 Traffic Design office located in Chattanooga, TN. The intern will assist with the submission and design of traffic projects. This will require the intern's involvement with team meetings, project site visits, project design, and CADD assignments. Interns will be familiarized with the project lifecycle, from concept review in PDN Stage 1 to final submission in PDN Stage 4.

Responsibilities

- Analyze intersections and perform Signal Warrant analysis.
- Analyze intersections using Synchro Software to determine operation improvements.
- Review crash data and learn best practices to improve safety at intersections.
- Prepare signing and pavement marking plans, low complexity traffic control plans, and/or assist with signal design plans as projects are available.

Minimum Qualifications

- Civil engineering major required
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2026 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2025.
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
