Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring a student intern for the Bridge Inspection section of the Region 3 office located in Nashville, TN. The Bridge Inspector Intern will complete a focused summer project centered on assessing, documenting, and improving understanding of the condition and performance of assigned bridge structures. The project will give the intern hands-on experience with inspection practices while producing a meaningful deliverable that supports TDOT's bridge management and maintenance decision-making.

Responsibilities

- Learn and apply bridge inspection procedures in accordance with TDOT and FHWA standards.
- Collect field data (measurements, photos, notes) during supervised bridge inspections.
- Evaluate structural elements for condition, defects, and maintenance needs.
- Organize and analyze inspection data to identify trends or priority issues.
- Develop a focused improvement or analysis component, such as documenting recurring defects, evaluating a specific structure type, or comparing current conditions to previous inspection cycles.

Minimum Qualifications

- Civil engineering major required
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2026 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2025.
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
- Experience in Microsoft office suite, MicroStation, Geopak, and Open Roads Designer preferred.
