Overview

The intern will be assigned an existing TDOT transportation improvement project to further develop in the project development process. The intern will meet with design team engineers and supervisors to determine action items needed to further develop the project plans. The intern will work with a design team engineer to begin plans and quantities development for the resurfacing project. The intern will also be assigned one resurfacing project to begin development.

Responsibilities

- Complete both the MicroStation and Geopak tutorials to obtain a basic knowledge of the tools and programs contained within these engineering applications.
- Meet with design team engineers and supervisors to determine action items.
- Utilize engineering tools necessary to begin plans development.
- Assist TDOT Roadway Design Engineers with ongoing project assignments.

Minimum Qualifications

- Engineering major required
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2026 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2025.
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
- Familiarity with foundational transportation engineering concepts
