Overview

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is currently hiring a student intern for the Region 3 Geodetics section, located in Nashville, TN. The summer intern will assist both field crews and office staff, gaining exposure to the full range of geodetic operations. Responsibilities include helping set and establish geodetic control points, locating survey features in the field, and staking proposed rights-of-way. The intern will also assist in producing OpenRoads Designer (ORD) models using data collected in the field. This internship is designed to provide hands-on experience with the technology and techniques used to create geodetic deliverables, offering a comprehensive understanding of TDOT's surveying processes.

Responsibilities

- Perform field surveys with a survey crew and collect topographic, drainage, and digital terrain model data
- Assist the crew in locating property and right of way monumentation and assist with the research necessary to accurately locate and determine property lines.
- Create survey deliverables utilizing multiple software packages including Carlson field and office software and OpenROADs Designer CADD software.
- Use various types of surveying equipment including GNSS equipment & Robotic Total Stations to collect survey data for transportation projects.

Minimum Qualifications

- Engineering, Land Surveying, or related major required
- Junior, or Senior Class Status required as of May 2026 OR recent Graduate as of Spring 2025.
- Legally authorized to work in the U.S.
- Property & Boundary Line Location experience preferred.
- OpenRoads Designer CADD software or other CADD software experience preferred.
