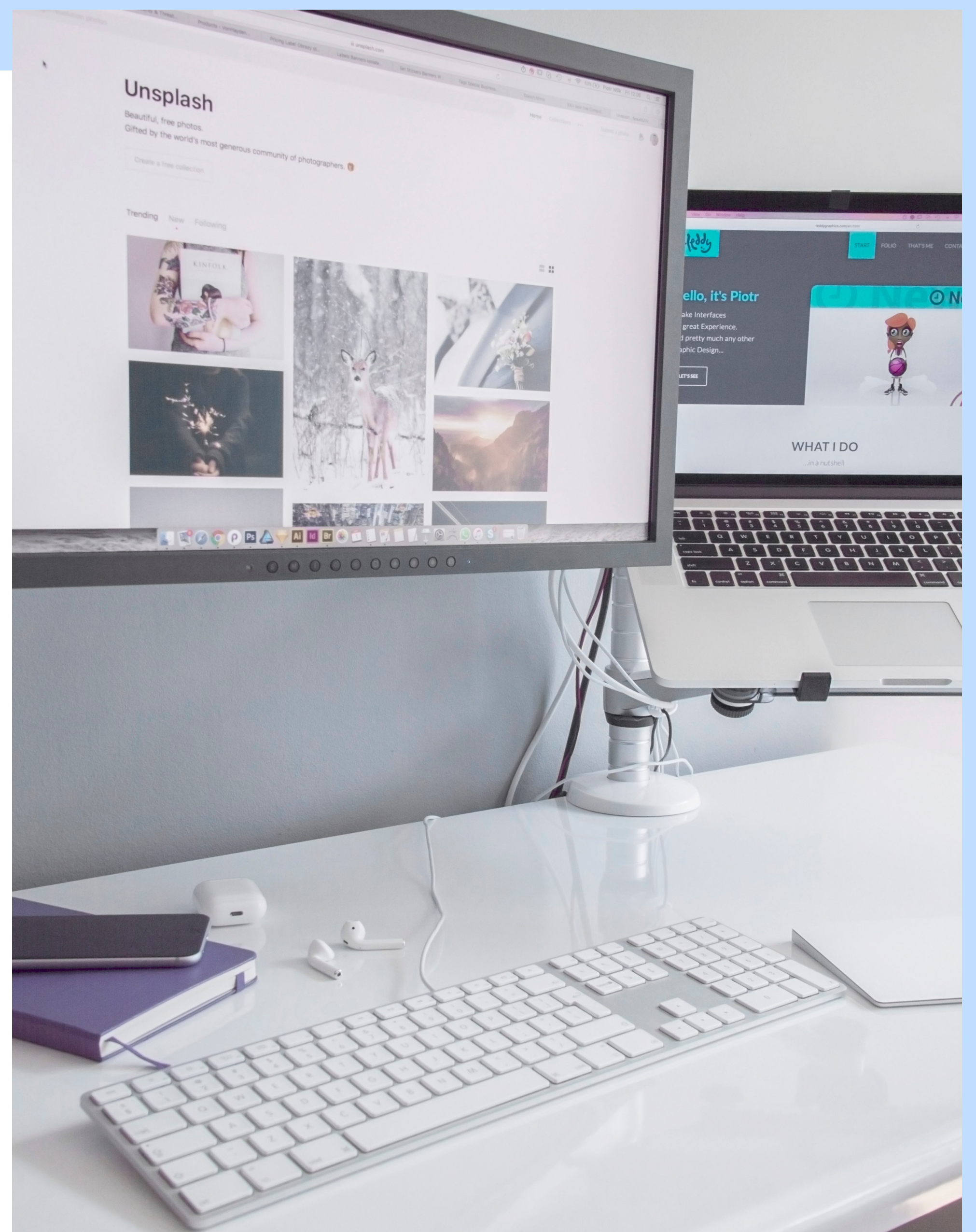


Tech Tip Tuesday

Ending Support for Internet Explorer – After June 15th, 2022, Microsoft will end support with Internet Explorer in Windows.

- **Microsoft Edge** is the replacement for Internet Explorer. Microsoft Edge is available on all tablets.
- All TDOT applications that required the use of Internet Explorer, have been tested and are now working in Microsoft Edge.

If anyone has any difficulties while using TDOT applications on Microsoft Edge, please contact the Service Desk.



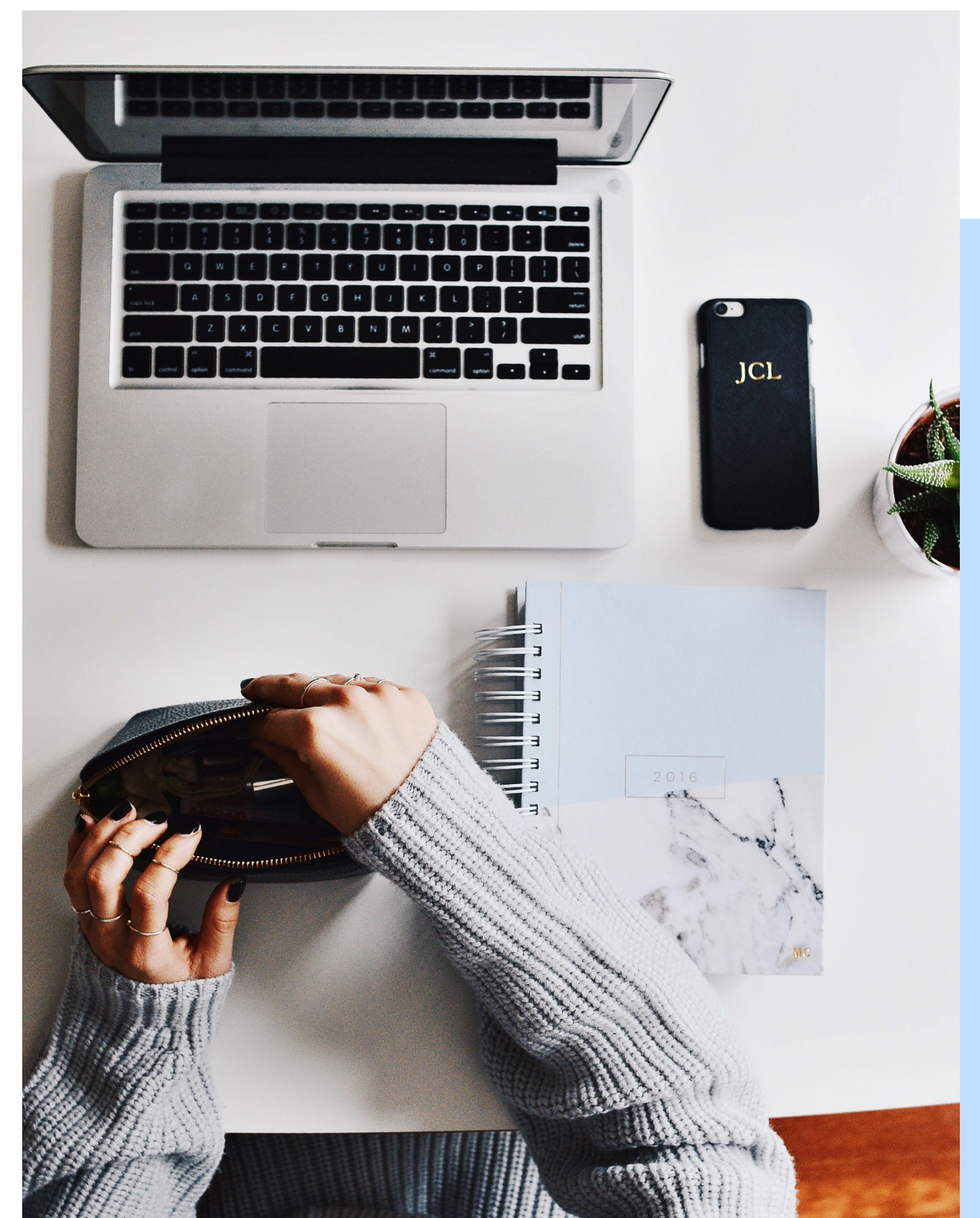

- Microsoft Teams chats are retained for 14 days.
- Documents deleted and sent to the Recycle Bin will be permanently deleted after 93 days.
- All customer content data and account-related data will be deleted 30 days after a user account is closed.
 - For example: Microsoft Forms owned by a terminated employee will be permanently deleted after 30 days.
